

COMMITMENT TO A NATIONAL VISION: ITS INFLUENCE ON DEVELOPMENT

ABSTRACT

Until recent times, the concept of national vision was not considered that important in the context of socio-economic development. Accordingly, not much study has been done and no theoretical framework has been formulated so far to explain the concept of national vision and its related ideas.
