

Law's Delays and Management of the Judicial Process

Abstract

This article addresses an important issue bearing on the image of the country's judiciary and the citizen's respect for the rule of law, viz., the issue of law's delays. The study is based on the writer's discussions with the members of the judiciary, legal practitioners and several other stakeholders. It diagnoses the causes of delay and recommends measures to expedite the judicial process.
